For your final project proposal, you can use the format of the pre-proposal or one of the examples of research proposals that are available in the pantry or on Blackboard. You are free to choose.

Maximum number of pages for the whole project proposal is 10 (references and Appendices not included).

Make sure that your proposal at least covers the following (rephrase if you like):

- 1. title and names of students in project team
- 2. abstract (150-300 words)
- 3. general introduction (200-400 words)
- 4. general problem analysis and research goals
- 5. <u>work package descriptions per subgroup</u>: title, names of students, introduction (including goals), state of the art, problem analysis (or: research question), proposed methodology, research plan. Maximum number of words: 1800 per subgroup.
- 6. integration plan for subtopics/work packages
- 7. conclusion
- 8. references
- 9. (Appendices, if applicable)
